The mission of the Southeast Side Experience Incubator (SSEI) Work Study Program is to employ St. Francis de Sales High School students in jobs and provide the resources to help students gain valuable skills and experience in a professional work environment.

Students gain employable skills plus the confidence that they can succeed in a professional environment. The work experiences provide insights to career paths that can impact student's college decisions and life.

SSEI contracts with partner companies throughout the Chicago, IL area and Northwest Indiana to fill entry-level positions at their places of business. Students are placed in teams of four and work throughout the school year (late August to June) except during school vacations like Christmas and Spring break. Student workers will be assigned to specific locations or work remotely from the school. Partner companies can hire full or partial teams. Partners pay a fee for the student team.

SSEI Benefits to businesses include:

- Work study is a cost-effective alternative to a full-time employee
- Student workers are employees of SSEI with a strong work ethic; no benefit costs, no employee related taxes to the business partner
- Student workers are provided job skills training by SSEI prior to the start date, plus ongoing support and training is provided to students
- Partners work with a relationship manager to ensure satisfaction
- Work study will help enhance your company's diversity and establish a professional relationship with potential full-time employees
