


WE KNOW

October 1st: Early Admission Process and Application Opens

Entrance Test and Interview:

Acceptance Notification:

January 15th: Early Applicants notified of acceptance

Regular Admission Opens:

January 31st: Regular admissions process begins (test date and open dates to come)

Application: Incoming freshmen must first apply. The application will be available on October 1st and can be found here: www.sfdshs.org/admission-application

Individual Family Tours with Panel Discussions: In order to social distance, all families who want to attend must sign up for their individual 50 minute slot that will include a 30 minute tour and 20 minute panel discussions.
